Terms and Conditions to participate for OCD-UK in the 2024 Great Manchester Run, which takes place on Sunday 26th May (the "Event")

OCD-UK Charity Registration Number: 1103210

By accepting a guaranteed entry into the Event. I agree with that:

Registration and participation

- 1. I will pay a non-refundable registration fee of £15
- 2. I will inform OCD-UK immediately if I am unable to take part in the event (this allows us to possibly reallocate the place).
- 3. I will wear the OCD-UK running top during the Event.

Minimum fundraising target

4. I pledge to raise a minimum of £150 for OCD-UK through my participation in the event (if using a charity guaranteed place).

Donations and payment terms

- 5. I will pay all offline sponsorship money collected on behalf of OCD-UK to the charity directly by:
 - Paying online at online at https://www.ocduk.org with your credit or debit card, or;
 - Paying online using either of our fundraising platforms such Enthuse or Just Giving, or;
 - Sending cheque made payable to "OCD-UK" to the charity office at: OCD-UK, 8 Chapel Street, Belper, Derbyshire DE56 1AR

Fundraising

- 6. I will collect money only on behalf of OCD-UK in connection with the event.
- 7. I will use only lawful means to fundraise for OCD-UK and will not do anything that harms or is likely to harm the reputation of the charity.
- 8. My fundraising for OCD-UK will not include;
 - Raising funds by carrying out door-to-door or unsolicited collections;
 - Collecting in any public place without first obtaining authorisation from the local authority and any other licences;
 - Collecting on private property or in shops or bars/pubs without first obtaining permission of the owner;
 - Conducting any raffle or lottery or putting on any public Event without first obtaining authorisation from the local authority and any other licences
- 9. I agree that OCD-UK can suspend my authority to fundraise and withdraw my entry to the event at any time by sending written notice via email or direct postal.

Personal data and images

OCD-UK may use any event photographs or videos for celebrating your achievement and for the purpose of marketing/encouraging future participation. These would be used online (i.e. our websites, social media) and on print materials (i.e. newsletters), for a period of four years.

10. I give permission for the free use of my name (we will use first name only), event picture/image, video, my Event comments in any future publicity, advertising, fundraising materials (including fundraising platforms) and/or promotion on the OCD-UK website, social media, leaflets and magazine.

Health, safety and fitness

- 11. I take part in the event at my own risk and will not hold OCD-UK or any connected persons responsible for any accident, injury or illness sustained to the fullest extent possible in law.
- 12. I will fully prepare myself for the physical challenge of the event and I will check with my doctor if appropriate to ensure that I am medically fit to participate in the event.
- 13. I will comply with any health and safety and other rules or guidelines issued by any event organiser representative or member of the emergency services.

Dates, changes and termination

- 14. This agreement will be valid from the date on which I sign, unless terminated earlier by OCD-UK.
- 15. OCD-UK may vary or terminate this agreement by giving written notice via email or direct post.
- 16. The event may be cancelled, or the date changed by the Event organisers at short notice (i.e. new pandemic rules).

Declaration and signature

17. I confirm that:

- I will be at least 15 years old on the day of the event.
- That if I am aged 15-17 you have parental permission to take part in the event for OCD-UK.
- I pledge to raise the minimum fundraising amount of £150
- I accept that by continuing with this registration I am accepting all the points stated in these terms and conditions.
